TRASH: Please use the provided trash receptacles throughout the event.

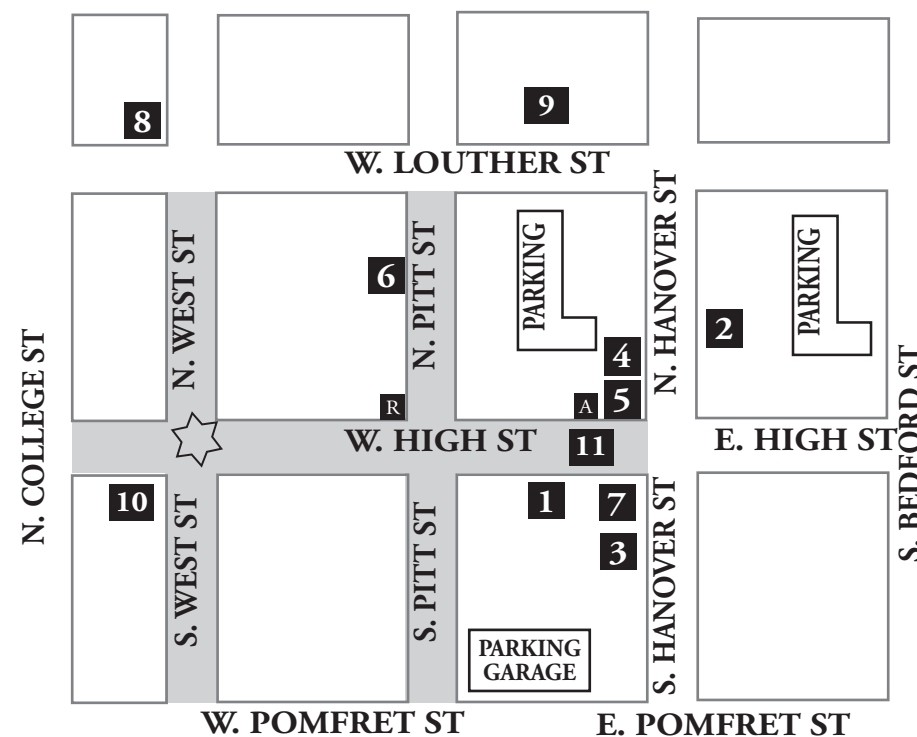
